Membership in the National Honor Society is based on four criteria: scholarship, service, leadership and character.

- ❖ Candidates must be a junior or senior
- ❖ Candidates must have a grade point average of 90 or better with no rounding

Application process for the National Honor Society

- ❖ List major awards received outside Coe-Brown, date received and advisor
- ❖ List major awards received at Coe-Brown, date received and advisor
- ❖ List participation in organizations or teams outside of Coe-Brown, date of participation and advisor
- ❖ List participation in organizations or teams at Coe-Brown, date of participation and advisor
- ❖ List all community service performed
- ❖ Write a proofread, formal essay on the following: Membership into the National Honor Society is based on scholarship, leadership, service and character. Write yourself a recommendation for election into the society.
  1. Typing the application is recommended.
  2. You need to turn in **13 copies** of your completed application **at a brief meeting on Tuesday, September 13 at 7:15 AM in room 112**. Each copy should be stapled together and three holed punched.
  3. Candidates will be reviewed by the entire faculty.
  4. A faculty council will review your application and with input from the entire faculty, vote on your membership application. The process should be completed by September 30.

The mandatory induction ceremony will be November 17.

# The National Honor Society Commitment

## All members must:

- ❖ Maintain a grade point average of 90 with no rounding.
- ❖ Maintain good character. This would include but is not limited to, only 1's and 2's on report cards, no detentions and absolutely no administrative referrals.
- ❖ Attend all meetings. Meetings will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month at 7:15 AM.
- ❖ Hold an NHS office or do 2 hours of community service not included in their senior portfolio or any other organization.
- ❖ Do one of the following choices: (1) sell 50-50 tickets at a home boys' basketball game or (2) volunteer at the phone-a-thon or (3) go to the NHS winter dance or (4) do 2 more hours of community service not included in their senior portfolio or any other organization. These hours can be more flexible than the ones above.

Community service can be done as an entire group or as part of a group with other members.

Any junior not fulfilling the above obligations will be removed from NHS and will have to reapply the next year. Any senior not fulfilling the above obligations by May 20 will be removed from NHS.
