Estimated cost is \$2000 (depending on airfare costs) for 9 days, 8 nights. This includes airfare, all meals in Panama, ground transportation and accommodations. It also includes full time, bilingual guides and entrance fees into parks. It does NOT include departure or visa taxes for Panama, personal purchases or gratuities.
