Senior Write-ups

*Please follow the below-listed guidelines EXACTLY for your senior write-ups! It will be due by **March 25th**. This is very important as the staff has strict deadlines for page submission.*

Your write-up should include the following information:

A) Your name (no nicknames)

B) Philosophy

This needs to be no longer than 25 words!

C) Activities and years (for example, tennis 9-11, student council 11-12, etc.)

D) Thanks/Memories

This section should be no longer than a total of **300 characters**, including spaces. There must be **NO abbreviations** and Standard English is required. The write-up must be school-appropriate.

The yearbook staff is aware that this is not a lot of room. Remember, though, that this is not the place to list every memory you have and thank every person you know. Use this space for the exceptional person(s) or experience in your life. Write something that will make sense to you many years from now.

PLEASE NOTE!!! The material in your write-up must be school appropriate. If you have any questions, see me before the deadline. The yearbook staff reserves the right to DELETE any write-up, partially or in its entirety, WITHOUT your consultation. DO NOT take the risk of having your entire write-up deleted - be appropriate! Also, if your write-up is too LONG, I will fit what I can, and delete WITHOUT your consultation.

How to submit this write-up: You **MUST** submit this write-up to MS. LASKY via email or on disk. Your write-up can be sent in an email to clasky@coebrown.org or you can write it in a Word document and save it on disk and hand it to MS. LASKY. We recommend typing it in Word regardless and using the character count option to assist the process. You can cut and paste into an email when you have finished.
